Business Professionals of America Alaska Association – Dress Code

A member of Business Professionals of America, Alaska Association, represents not only themselves while at conferences but also their school, hometown, and the entire organization.

Following the Business Professionals of America National Center Official Dress Code established by the Board of Trustees, the Alaska Association's Office Dress Code is as follows:

BPA's Official Professional Dress Code

Required for the following events: State Leadership Conference General Sessions, all competitive events (judged, non-judged & open), Business Meetings, Workshops, Day of Service:

- Dress slacks, dress shirt, and tie
- Pant or skirt suit
- Suit, dress shirt, and tie
- Dress skirt or dress slacks with coordinated blouse and/or sweater
- Sport coat, coordinated dress slacks, dress shirt, and tie
- BPA blazer with dress skirt or dress slacks with blouse or sweater
- BPA blazer with dress slacks, dress shirt, and tie

* Dress shoes with dress socks or dress sandals with heel are required

* Skirt length may be no greater than two inches above the top of the knee

* This excludes all denim for any of the above

BPA's Official Casual Dress Code

Required for the following events: State Leadership Conference Special Event

- Sportswear (jeans), pants, and shirt, t-shirt, and shorts

* Footwear is required with all of the above

Alaska BPA's Official Business Casual Dress Code

May be required by local or state advisor for Alaska BPA activities:

- Casual slacks (no jeans)
- Polo or dress shirt (no t-shirts)

* Dress shoes with dress socks or dress sandals with heel are required

The following are deemed unacceptable during BPA activities:

- Strapless, spaghetti straps, tube tops, halter tops, midriff tops
- Spandex, lycra or transparent clothing
- Cut-offs or ragged clothing
- Clothing with inappropriate words and pictures
- Swim suits must be covered with appropriate attire while in any area except the swimming pool or designated sunbathing area.
