- Footwear required with all of the above
- The following is not acceptable for casual dress—halter tops, tube tops, cut-offs, ragged clothing, and bare feet

<u>Professional Dress</u> required for the following events: General Sessions, all Competitive Events (judged, non-judged, and open), Campaign Rally, and Caucuses.

<u>Casual Dress</u> for Chapter Activities (The following is not acceptable for Casual Dress: tank tops, halter tops, tube tops, cut offs, ragged clothing, thongs, and bare feet.)

<u>Members who are not dressed within Dress Code guidelines</u> will be asked to leave.




