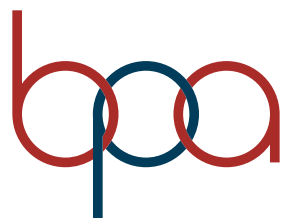

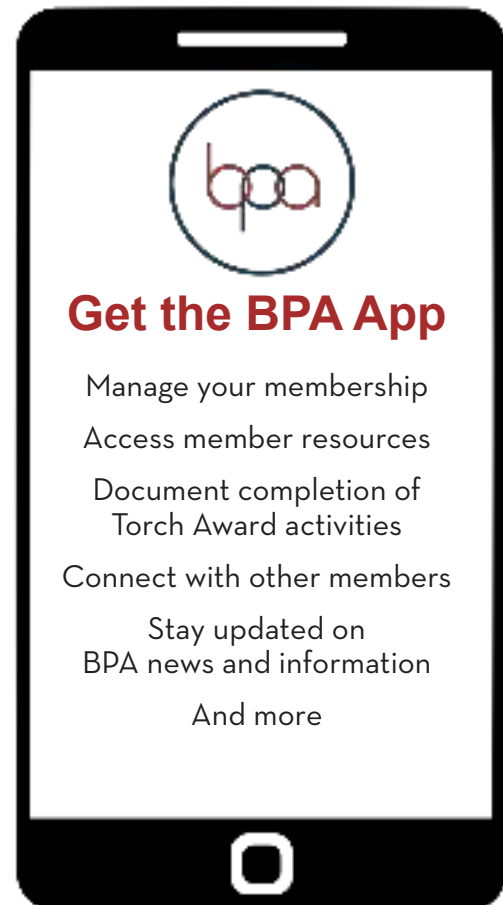
Chapter Affiliation Member Model Using Perkins V Funds

Many BPA state associations are offering a new, optional membership model that allows member dues to be paid from a school's Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act funds (commonly known as "Perkins V").

The new Chapter Affiliation Membership model is designed to allow entire classes to join BPA and participate in opportunities available for members. The main difference, which some schools may find advantageous, is how chapter dues are calculated and paid.

Schools choosing the Chapter Affiliation option can use Perkins V funds to pay a tiered fee based on the total number of student members. Perkins V is a federal investment in Career and Technical Education (CTE). Advisors are encouraged to speak with the school's Perkins V coordinator about the Chapter Affiliation option.

The traditional membership model with individual students joining the BPA chapter and the new Chapter Affiliation (in participating states) are both available in the registration system at <https://register.bpa.org>.

Professional Awards Due March 1

Advisor of the Year

Recognizes a chapter advisor who has made significant contributions to BPA

Emerging Advisor of the Year

Recognizes a chapter advisor with five or fewer years of service who has made significant contributions

Emerging Professional of the Year

Recognizes an alumni member who has had professional achievements and contributed to BPA within their first five years of service

Hall of Fame

Recognizes individuals for significant contributions to BPA at the local, state, and national levels for 10 or more years

Outstanding Service

Recognizes individuals for outstanding service to BPA at the national level

Student of the Year

Recognizes members who have made significant contributions to BPA and participated in BPA activities

Service Learning Awards Due March 15

Community Service

Recognizes chapter involvement in service activities such as blood drives, clothing drives, food drives, disaster relief, or community shelters

Environmental Action/Awareness

Recognizes chapters for environmental stewardship activities or events such as recycling, composting, or promoting conservation

Safety Awareness

Recognizes chapters for involvement in safety programs such as workplace safety, traffic safety, seat belt use, personal safety, drug awareness, and anti-violence awareness

Service Learning Individual

Recognizes members with a minimum of 500 hours of service learning to the community and who have earned the President's Volunteer Service Award in the same membership year

Special Olympics

Recognizes chapters for support for the Special Olympics, BPA's national service project

Special Recognition Awards Due March 15

BPA Marketing and Public Relations

Recognizes chapters that have promoted BPA in the school or community through newsletters, outreach to local media, a website, or in other ways

BPA Merit Scholar Award

Recognizes members and advisors for knowledge of BPA's history, traditions, programs, and activities; *test administered at the National Leadership Conference*

Chapter Activities Award of Excellence

Recognizes chapters for outstanding achievements in activity participation and chapter management

Membership Explosion Award

Recognizes chapters that had at least 15 members in 2021–2022 and experienced at least a 30 percent increase in 2022–2023; *no application required*

Recruiter of the Year

Recognizes members who have achieved success in recruiting new BPA members and chapters

Social Media

Recognizes chapters that have achieved success in promoting chapter activities and events using social media

The Professional Cup

Recognizes BPA state associations for outstanding chapter participation in the BPA Cares Awards; *no application required*

Other Awards

President's Volunteer Service Award (PVSA)

Torch Awards recognize members for completing activities that enhance their professionalism, leadership, and skills that will be valuable in future careers.

To participate in Torch Awards, members complete activities in seven Torch categories and document them in an online Torch résumé, which becomes a valuable record of leadership and service activities. Members can achieve four levels of recognition—from the chapter level to the national level—by earning the required points in each category and submitting the résumé by the appropriate deadline.
