MICHAEL IVANOV is a dynamic speaker and best-selling author who has impacted thousands of people with his message of resilience. 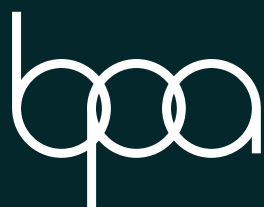
