Barrett LeMaster

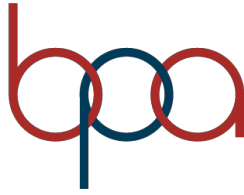

Kaylee Jane Bates

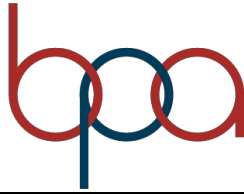
