

Pin Trading!?



Pin trading is a time honored tradition at the Business Professionals of America National Leadership Conference. Since Wisconsin does not have secondary or middle divisions, our pins are harder to get and highly sought after. There are 23 states, plus Puerto Rico, so have at least that many if you want to trade with every state... if you can. Some are harder to get, like Alaska. Some states have more than one design. Keep that in mind when making your pin purchases. Have enough or you just might miss out on a good one!

Pro Tip #1 Bring a lanyard to display all of the Wisconsin pins that you have. That way, people can see what you have. Before you know it, that lanyard will be filled with pins from other states. I keep extra in my pocket, in case I find a blinky one that I want to trade for.

Pro Tip #2 Idaho has two separate pins, one is official and the other is a potato from the Idaho Potato Council. Both are cool to get!

Conference Dress Codes

Professional Dress Code Required for the following events: General Sessions, all Competitive Events (judged, non-judged, and open)

Women:

Pant or skirt suit.

Dress skirt or dress slacks with coordinated blouse and/or sweater.

Business professional "dress."

BPA blazer with dress skirt or dress slacks and blouse or sweater.

Dress shoes or dress sandals with heel are required with all of the above.

Skirt length may be no greater than two inches above the top of the knee.

This excludes all denim for any of the above.

Men:

Dress slacks, dress shirt, and tie.

Suit, dress shirt, and tie.

Sport coat, coordinated dress slacks, dress shirt, and tie.

BPA blazer with dress slacks, dress shirt, and tie.

Dress shoes and dress socks are required with all of the above.

This excludes all denim for any of the above.

Casual Dress Code Required for the following events: Tours, Special Events *Women*:

Sportswear (jeans), pants, and shirt, T-shirt, and shorts.

Footwear required with all of the above.

Men:

Sportswear (jeans), pants and shirt, T-shirt, and shorts.

Footwear required with all of the above.

The following are unacceptable during BPA activities:

Strapless, spaghetti straps, tube tops, halter tops, midriff tops.

Spandex, lycra, or transparent clothing.

Cut-offs or ragged clothing.

Clothing with inappropriate words and pictures.

Swim suits must be covered with appropriate attire while in any area except the swimming pool or designated sunbathing area.
