Scholarship Overview:

The Mike Tokheim Scholarship was established by Wisconsin BPA State Officers to recognize outstanding members in our organization. Scholarship recipients will exemplify the core values of Business Professionals of America: leadership, service, and extraordinary involvement. There will be a maximum of 4 awards given during the 2022 State Leadership Conference (SLC) in the amount of at least \$200.

Scholarship Requirements

Applicants must meet the following scholarship requirements:

- A member in good standing with the BPA organization
- Minimum cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Submit deadlines by the deadline of February 14, 2022 at 11:59 p.m. CST

PLEASE NOTE: Advisors and Alumni members are not eligible for this scholarship.

Scholarship Instructions:

Applicants must complete the application by no later than February 14, 2022. Applications that are received after this time will not be reviewed for consideration. Recipients will be announced during the 2022 SLC Awards Session.

Applications are not required for the Merit Scholar, The Professional Cup or Membership Explosion Award. These awards are given directly through National BPA.

The purpose of the Professional Awards Program is to acknowledge the dedication and service of our supporters. The awards available in this category include the Advisor of the Year Award, Emerging Advisor of the Year Award, Emerging Professional of the Year Award, Outstanding Student of the Year, Hall of Fame Award and Outstanding Service Award.
