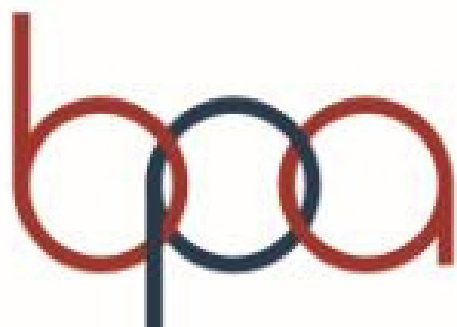

The State Pin Contest is a yearly BPA tradition, and we are currently accepting submissions for this year's contest! This is a great way to demonstrate your creative skills and make your mark on the state and national organization.

Since Wisconsin is a smaller state association with only 1 membership level, our state pin is highly coveted by members at the National Leadership Conference.

CONTEST GUIDELINES:

Pin Contest entries cannot exceed a size of 2" x 2", cannot include any gaps or holes in the design, and they must be submitted in PDF format.

Additionally, designs cannot include any copyrighted material or designs. If you need ideas, be sure to check out the designs on this page - they were created by former Wisconsin BPA members!

HOW YOU CAN PARTICIPATE

Any Wisconsin BPA member, advisor or Alumni is eligible to participate. Submissions will be accepted through **SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 20, 2022 by 11:59pm**

As an extra bonus for student members: anyone who submits a design can earn 5 Torch Award points under Service 229, and the winner of the contest is eligible for Service 230.

Scholarship Overview:

The Mike Tokheim Scholarship was established by Wisconsin BPA State Officers to recognize outstanding members in our organization. Scholarship recipients will exemplify the core values of Business Professionals of America: leadership, service, and extraordinary involvement. There will be a maximum of 4 awards given during the 2022 State Leadership Conference (SLC) in the amount of at least \$200.

Scholarship Requirements

Applicants must meet the following scholarship requirements:

- A member in good standing with the BPA organization
- Minimum cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Submit deadlines by the deadline of February 20, 2022 at 11:59 p.m. CST

PLEASE NOTE: Advisors and Alumni members are not eligible for this scholarship.

Scholarship Instructions:

Applicants must complete the application by no later than February 20, 2022. Applications that are received after this time will not be reviewed for consideration. Recipients will be announced during the 2022 SLC Awards Session.

The purpose of the Special Recognition Awards Program is to encourage individuals and chapters to support and promote their organizations. The awards available in this category include the BPA Marketing and Public Relations, BPA Merit Scholar, Chapter Activities Award of Excellence, Recruiter of the Year Award, Membership Explosion Award, Social Media Award, and the Professional Cup. Applications are not required for the Merit Scholar, The Professional Cup or Membership Explosion Award. These awards are given directly through National BPA.

PROFESSIONAL AWARDS

The purpose of the Professional Awards Program is to acknowledge the dedication and service of our supporters. The awards available in this category include the Advisor of the Year Award, Emerging Advisor of the Year Award, Emerging Professional of the Year Award, Outstanding Student of the Year, Hall of Fame Award and Outstanding Service Award.

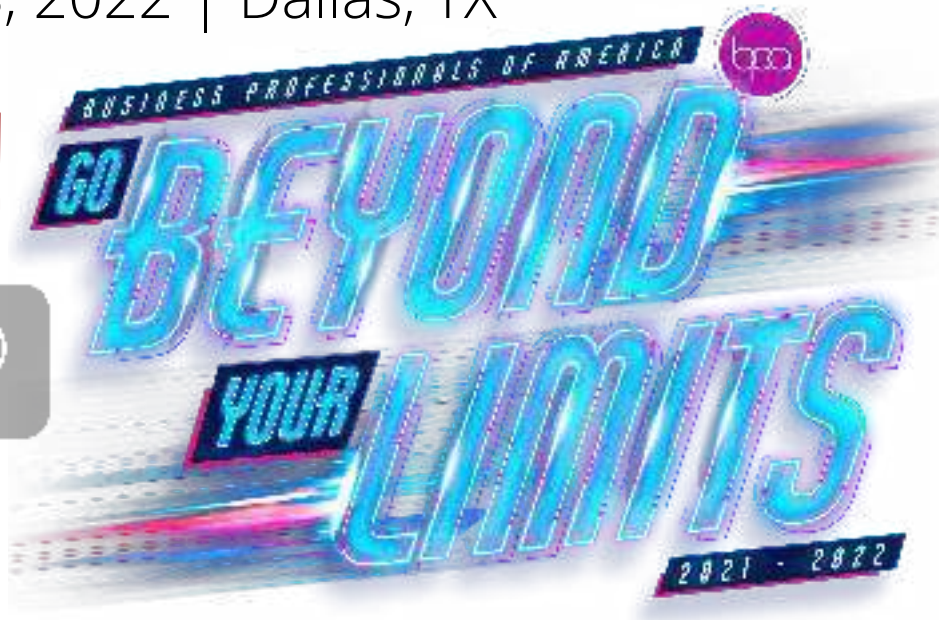

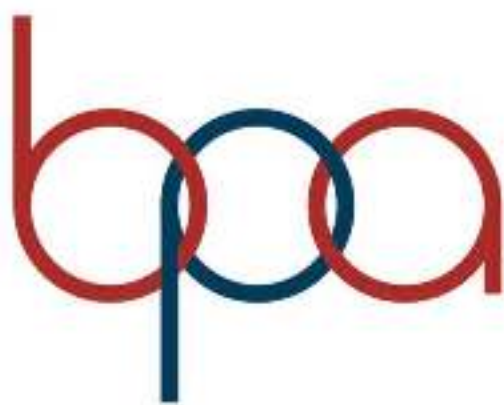
