Amendment I

Amend the Secondary Division Bylaws, Article XII - Electronic Meeting by striking out “standing and special committees” AND inserting “standing committees, special committees, and the Secondary membership”.

Current Language	Effect of Proposed Amendment
<p>The Executive Council, standing and special committees are authorized to meet by telephone conference or through other electronic communications media so long as all the members may simultaneously hear each other and participate during the meeting.</p>	<p>The Executive Council, standing and special committees <i>standing committees, special committees, and the Secondary membership</i> are authorized to meet by telephone conference or through other electronic communications media so long as all the members may simultaneously hear each other and participate during the meeting.</p>

Rationale: To comply with what is set forth by the Code of Regulations and have the Secondary Bylaws also confirm that the Secondary Division membership is authorized to convene and conduct business through electronic means.
